Dear Parents/Carers,

It is essential, for your child's health, that school have an in date, prescribed inhaler and spacer for immediate use should they need it.

Please note that it is the responsibility of parents/carers to:

- notify the school if their child has asthma,
- supply their child with a named inhaler and spacer in a named clear plastic box,
- notify the School Office if their child's medication is to be supervised, and if there are any changes in their child's condition or medication,
- check the use-by-date of their child's inhaler, ensuring it has not expired.

If your child suffers from asthma and the school are already aware of this, but you think your child's medical records need updating, then please come to the school office to make any amendments.

If you child suffers from asthma and the school have NOT been informed, then it is <u>paramount</u> that the necessary medical form is completed as soon as possible. You can collect one from the School Office or go to our school website to download one. (key informaton, school information tabs).

The school holds an emergency salbutamol inhaler, which should only be used by children who have written parental consent for its use. **Please ensure you have completed the consent form, which is also available on school website.** The emergency inhaler does not replace the need for your child's own inhaler to be in class, especially during the current COVID 19 circumstances.
