EXPLORING WINTER THROUGH DANCE

This half term, the children in Yr1 have been exploring their topic of Winter through movement and the use of props. Together, they have worked hard to create a piece of Dance which includes them exploring—Getting ready to play in the snow, building a snowman, blizzard, ice shapes and gathering back inside to the warmth. They have explored working with a partner, in small groups and as a whole group.



FS2 have worked on their creative skills— they have explored mirroring a partner, learning and remembering motif's and giving ideas in order to create movement together.

They have used props such as snowballs, feathers and scarves and used these effectively whilst performing.
