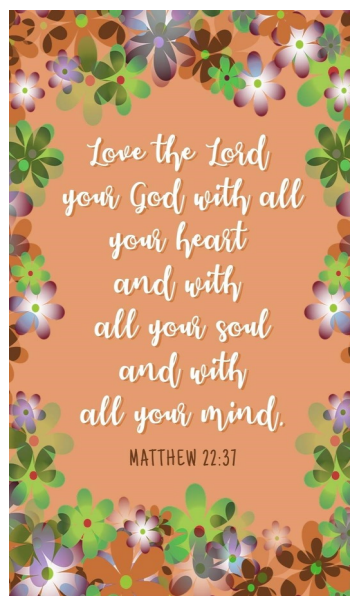


## Statutory Assessments
